## SSCD Club Code of Conduct and Ethics Policy

*Southern Ski Club for the Disabled*, (The Club) expects the highest standards from all members and guests of the club participating in snow sports.

### **SSCD will strive to ensure all members and guests of the Club will;**

- Not use inappropriate language or gestures, including foul, sexist, abusive, racist or prejudicial language or tolerate it from other members or guests.
- Display high standards of behaviour.
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed.
- Conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable steps to protect their own safety and that of others.
- Promote the positive aspects of snow sport and fair play.
- Encourage all participants to respect the decision of officials and avoid arguing with officials.
- Recognise good performance and not just good results.
- Place well-being and safety above the development of performance.
- Respect children and vulnerable adults' opinions when making decisions about their participation in snow sport.
- Abide by the club's Policies.
- Understand that any breach of Policies may result in disciplinary action.
- Not to use the internet or social media to make derogatory remarks about other people involved in snow sport, or clubs, or anything related to snow sport that could be interpreted as wrong, unkind or that could bring the sport or club into disrepute.
